A RESOLUTION (1) AUTHORIZING CERTAIN PARCELS OF PROPERTY ACQUIRED BY POLK COUNTY, TENNESSEE AT PREVIOUS DELINQUENT TAX SALES TO BE OFFERED FOR SALE AT AN AMOUNT LESS THAN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF TAXES, PENALTY, COST, AND INTEREST ACCUMULATED ON THE PARCEL OF PROPERTY, (2) ESTABLISHING THE MINIMUM BID AMOUNT FOR EACH PARCEL OF PROPERTY, (3) AUTHORIZING THE OFFER OF EACH PARCEL OF PROPERTY FOR SALE AT THE MINIMUM BID AMOUNT, (4) AUTHORIZING THE SALE OF EACH PARCEL OF PROPERTY TO THE PARTY MAKING THE HIGHEST AND BEST BID, IF THE HIGHEST AND BEST BID IS EQUAL TO OR GREATER THAN THE MINIMUM BID AMOUNT, SUBJECT TO THE RIGHT OF REDEMPTION (IF APPLICABLE), AND (5) AUTHORIZING THE COUNTY EXECUTIVE TO SIGN QUITCLAIM DEEDS ON BEHALF OF POLK COUNTY, TENNESSEE TO THE PARTY MAKING THE HIGHEST AND BEST BID ON EACH PARCEL OF PROPERTY, IF THE HIGHEST AND BEST BID IS EQUAL TO OR GREATER THAN THE MINIMUM BID AMOUNT.

WHEREAS, Polk County, Tennessee acquired the parcels of property, identified in Exhibit "A" attached hereto and incorporated herein by reference, at previous Delinquent Tax Sales.
